How the Dance Year Works

- We charge our fees **per term. There are (4) terms from September to June.**
 - Fall = *September to October*
 - Winter 1 = *November to January*
 - Winter 2 = *January to March*
 - Spring = *April to June*
- **Each term has 8 weeks**
- Types of classes offered at A New DAEI:
 - 45 minutes = Technique Classes
 - 30 minutes = Special Technique Class
 - 1 hour = Tumbling Class

- *Technique Classes:*
 - Hip Hop, Ballet, Acro, Jazz, Breakdance, Traditional African, Afrofusion, Afrobeat, Dancehall, Soca Dancehall, Chutney, Capoeira), Competition Classes (Group, Trio, Duet, Solo)
- *Special Technique Classes:*
 - Power Moves for Street Dancers, Stretch, Flexibility & Conditioning, Jumps, Tricks & Turns, Contemporary, Lyrical
- *Tumbling Class*

We have a Winter Showcase (December) and a Year-End Showcase (June) which see our children perform on stage for a live audience.

In the event of any lockdowns or pandemic events we will revert to a virtual schedule.

Important General Information

Costume Deposit of \$75 per technique class will be invoiced at the end of September and due October. No deposit is required for 30 minute special technique classes.

There is an annual registration fee of \$15.00 +HST per family that is non-refundable.

All Term Fees, Registration Fees, Costume Deposits, Competition Entry Fee Deposits and Competition Entry Fees are non-refundable.

Drop-In dancers and Special Technique classes are not choreographed into the annual year-end recital and costumes will not be ordered. If a specific drop-in class student would like to participate in the recital, costumes will be discussed with the instructors and management.

Competitive classes are eligible for Multi-Class discounts and Family Packages.

Not included in the Multi-Class Discounts or Student Packages: Competition Solos/Duets/Trios, Photoshoots, Acting Courses or any fees not approved by Management.

Items not eligible for additional discounts: special promotions, dance deals, family packages, team/studio wear, costume deposits, costume balances, competition fee balances.

Important Competition Team Information

- **Mandatory Team Wear for Competition Dancers**
 - Each dancer is required to have the studio sweat pants/jogger. The final cost will be given to parents/guardians in October and payable before the end of December of that same calendar year or prior to the start of competition for that year.
- **Technique Class Costume Deposit: \$75 per class (deposits are not taxed)**

- Competitive Class Costume Deposit: \$100 per competition class (deposits are not taxed).
- Competition Entry Fee Deposit: \$100 (deposits are not taxed)
- Entry fees are determined by the respective Competition Companies and are non-refundable.
- Total Entry fees must be paid *before* the first competition in full.
- Some travel may be required for competitions.
- To compete in a Trio, Duet, or Solo the dancer must be enrolled in the group competitive class and pre-requisite technique class. This will enable the dancer to learn at a more efficient rate instead of wasting time...and your money!
