

Important General Information

There is an annual registration fee of \$20.00 per family that is non-refundable for Fall/Winter/Spring programs.

Costume Deposit of \$75.00 per technique class will be invoiced at the end of September and due October 31 of each year if registering before that date. If registered after the Costume Deposit will be charged at the first class and due within 14 business days.

There is an annual DAEI Elite program fee of \$40 +HST that is non-refundable. This includes our first team performance top.

Parents/Guardians can pay for services online using debit or credit cards. Additional fees apply. Cash payments are accepted in-person. We do not accept cheques unless they are from management-approved organizations (no personal cheques accepted).

All Term Fees, Registration Fees, Costume Deposits, Competition Entry Fee Deposits and Competition Entry Fees are non-refundable.

Drop-In dancers and classes are not choreographed into the annual year-end recital and costumes will not be ordered. If a specific drop-in class would like to participate in the recital, costumes will be discussed with parents, instructors and management.

All competitive classes are by invitation or audition only. Upon selection onto the competitive team the dancer must also enrol in the mandatory Technique classes and

must also participate in a minimum number of hours of weekly training. Competitive classes are eligible for Multi-Class discounts and Family Packages

Not included in Multi-Class Discounts or Student Discount Packages: DAEI Elite Dance Crew, Competition Solos/Duets/Trios, Photoshoot, Acting Course

Items not eligible for additional discounts unless approved by the Director: special promotions, dance deals, family packages, costume deposits, competition entry fee deposits, registration fees, competition entry fees, team wear, costume balances, competition fee balances

Cancellation Policy

If the class or program cancellation is due to an issue or situation occurring from A New DAEI, the class(es) will be rescheduled and new dates/times sent to those enrolled in a class. For example, teacher is sick and no substitute is available.

If a parent/guardian who has paid for services wishes to cancel their registration with A New DAEI

- Before the class(es) paid for begins: We will offer a full refund of class tuition and any costume deposits
- After the program begins: We will keep a credit on file for the family
- A Cancellation fee of 5% will apply.
- Credits on file: an additional 15% fee will apply annually, commencing on the 1st registration day of each new season.

Student Illness:

- We can offer a make-up class if one is available
- We will not provide a credit or refund for the days missed

Important Competition Information

Mandatory Items:

- Team Wear Zip Hoodie or Pullover Hoodie required for each dancer
- Competitive Class Costume <u>Deposit</u>: \$100 per comp class (deposits are not taxed)
- Technique Class Costume *Deposit*: \$75 per class (deposits are not taxed)
- Competition Entry Fee *Deposit*: \$100 (deposits are not taxed)
- Entry fees are determined by the respective Competition Companies and are non-refundable
- Total Entry fees to be paid by the date of the first competition in full
- Some travel may be required for competitions as not all events take place at local venues.
- To compete in a Trio, Duet or Solo the dancer must be enrolled in the group competitive class and pre-requisite technique classes. This will enable the dancer to learn at a more efficient rate instead of wasting time... and your money!
